Residents' Association Committee

RAC NEWS

Your new committee have been busy recently getting our “feet under the desk” and working to knock over a few long standing issues. Below I have summarised a few items , but you can read more about the committee activities in the August Committee Meeting minutes .

- A new fridge for the bar has been ordered . Should be here in the week of Aug 26. The bar will need to be modified to accommodate the new and much larger fridge. Please bear with us during these temporary arrangements for the bar service.
- One 8 cubic meter Skip bin for residents will be in place during October for a couple of weeks. Exact dates to be notified later
- Pool umbrellas and new pool gate have been approved and will be delivered and installed soon. The lead time for these are a few weeks but they should here well ahead of the hot weather.

Meet and Greet team for new residents has been formed with Prue Curtis, Bron Kennedy and Leonie Quint volunteering for this really exciting initiative. It has long been acknowledged that we should be doing a better job in welcoming new residents to our village and showing what we have to offer the new “chums”.

A couple of “back of house” matters have been addressed as well. These include a review of our current bar Liquor License. Currently we have a Commercial Liquor License and it could change to a Community License. One of the benefits of the Community License is that not all volunteers need an RSA certificate, but they must work with a volunteer with an RSA . This change could see an increase in bar volunteer numbers as the “hurdle” to work behind the bar is not so onerous. Also the change in license gives us an annual saving in fees to the government of almost \$400. However, before we pull the trigger on this change , a thorough evaluation of the implications on the bar operation will be made. This may take a bit of time.

Also we will purchase a new POS system for Bar . This new POS system is fully automated separating payments, providing accurate input, recording and reporting and quicker. This system will allow payment for drinks, events and raffles all at the bar.

Also , as I foreshadowed at the recent AGM, we hope to begin open discussions on a couple of constitutional changes for the Residents Association at the October QGM. These relate to length of tenure by committee members and the current one vote per one accommodation unit rule. After some discussions and guidance from the ARQRV, we hope to be able to at least begin mature debate on these issues in October.

The next meeting of the RAC will take place on Tuesday, 17th September, 2024, at 9.30 a.m.
